

James Hudson - Short Biography

London-based jazz vocalist James Hudson has all of the unique qualities that epitomise the 21st century crooner. An assured and charming performer, his natural affinity with an audience is complemented by effortless vocals, tasteful phrasing and interpretive prowess.

James's debut album, which is set for release in late 2020, will be the biggest milestone of his career so far. Over a year in the making, the album features James and his band performing brand-new arrangements of classics from The Great American Songbook. Greatly influenced by Nat King Cole, Frank Sinatra and Tony Bennett, James is fuelled by a desire to play his part in keeping jazz standards alive.

In-demand at many of London's most respected jazz clubs, James has recently performed to sold-out crowds at Ronnie Scott's Jazz Club and Pizza Express Jazz Club Soho. He has appeared at the EFG London Jazz Festival, Leeds Jazz Festival and the Snape Proms. James regularly guests with some of the top big bands and orchestras in the industry and has travelled across the world to perform - appearing in Spain, India, Norway, Egypt, Switzerland, Malta, France and Monte Carlo.
